Minimum Requirement

1. The aircraft should be of Airbus H145 (EC145-T2) with full/medical capabilities.
2. The aircraft should be able to accommodate two passengers where required.
3. Two aircrafts are required for operations, each aircraft based in two bases, one in north of Male' and one in south of Male'.
4. Aircrafts shall be operated on ACMI Lease terms
5. The infrastructure and investment cost shall be borne by Owner/Lessor
6. IASL shall facilitate the Helicopter operations and assist in an administrative capacity for all aspects of the Helicopter operations.
7. IASL shall assist in the Maintenance efforts through provision of mechanics to assist in the operations.
